Located on the Museum Campus in South Bend, Indiana, The Studebaker National Museum is the perfect addition to your tour itinerary. Housed in a 55,000 square foot facility, the Studebaker National Museum is more than just cars; it's a tour through history and an exploration of our industrial manufacturing heritage.

Museum Highlights

Home to a priceless collection of vehicles, artwork, archival material, and artifacts spanning nearly 200 years, The Studebaker National Museum is a state of the art facility designed to be reminiscent of the Studebaker dealerships of the 20's and 30's.

- On display is the largest collection of presidential carriages outside of the Smithsonian Institution, including the carriage that President Lincoln arrived in at the Ford Theatre the night he was assassinated.
- Recreated is the Studebaker brother's 1852 blacksmith shop and the first carriage they made.
- The Studebaker family's Conestoga wagon that brought them west in the 1800's is a featured highlight.
- Military history is recorded in a collection of vehicles from six wars.
- From horses to horsepower, from ragtops to hardtops, and more - it's all part of the Studebaker National Museum.

The Museum Campus



Complement your tour of the The Studebaker National Museum, with a visit to the adjacent Center for History and Copshaholm, the Oliver Mansion.

The Center for History includes the Ernestine M. Raclin Gallery of Notre Dame History, historical displays about the people of the St. Joseph River valley, and several galleries of changing exhibits.

Featuring 38 rooms of original furnishings, and built in 1896, Copshaholm is the Victorian mansion of industrialist Joseph Doty Oliver and is surrounded by 2.5 acres of formal gardens.
